PROFESSIONAL AND SOCIETY SKILLS

After he graduated in London in 1977, where he obtained the Part III studies, he became member of the Royal Institute of British Architects. He was as well registered in the Order of Architects of the province of Trieste at no. 291 since 1981. He was elected President of the Order of Architects of Trieste for two terms, from 2000 to 2009.

In this period, he is the Coordinator of the Orders of the 13 Provinces of Friuli Venezia Giulia, Veneto and Trentino Alto Adige. In 2004 he was awarded for his collaboration between the Italian national orders and the cross-border orders with the honorary registration of the Croatian Chamber of Architects.

Since 2000 he represents the National PPC Architects Council (il Consiglio Nazionale Architetti PPC) at the Architects Council of Europe (ACE) in Brussels and in the two-year period 2004/5 he is elected vice president. In 2013 he applied for the presidency of the ACE and was elected twice, carrying out the maximum of two mandates foreseen by the Statute.

The ACE, with permanent headquarters in Brussels, is an organization composed of 47 Orders and Associations of architects from 32 European countries, representing over 600.000 members. The ACE works for the promotion of Architecture, monitoring the relevant EU legislation and through specific work groups, exploring various topics, entertaining and developing synergies with other European and global professional organizations.

In 2014 Lazzari received the medal and honorary registration at the American Institute of Architects and in the same year the Presidential Medal of Honor of the Royal Institute of British Architects.

He has participated as a jury member of National and International Competition Commissions, mostly organized with UIA rules - since 2005, the most important to date:

Barbara Cappochin Award;

AIA International awards;

Renovation of the former Cottonificio ANNONE VENETO area (PN);

New Judiciary Center in TRENTO;

New laboratories for the EU Joint Research Center at ISPRA;

Project by invitation in the second phase for Campidoglio 2 - ROME;

Competition for the connection of the Bering Strait - SEOUL, South Korea;

Bridge and project of the Riva DRAVA on the occasion of the appointment as city of Culture - MARIBOR (SLO); International competition for young architects - ANTALYA, Turkey;

2 editions of the 2nd year architecture students' national competition - TIMISOARA, Romania.

During his presidency of the ACE, he designed and established the ACE Diploma Prize, together with the EAAE (European Association for Architectural Education) with the support of the Ion Mincu University of Bucharest, for the best diploma project of all European architecture schools. He participated in the drafting of the announcement and was President of the jury. There were three editions and the last one saw the presentation of 156 projects from 29 countries. Last year, Lazzari concluded the agreement for the merger of the award with the Young Talent Award from the Mies van der Rohe foundation, starting in 2018.

PEDAGOGICAL AND SCIENTIFIC SKILLS

Luciano Lazzari has had collaborative relationships as an external examiner for end-of-course projects with the universities of Syracuse University, Florence and Westminster University, London. For three years he held a design course for final diploma students at the University of Graz.

He is currently invited to join the AUIC Steering Committee of the Politecnico di Milano.

ARCHITECTURAL WORK

The thirty-year experience of architectural activity of professional study also includes urban design aimed at the recovery of city spaces and urban furniture. The firm has extensive experience in the field of recovery and re-use of existing buildings and complexes, with considerable residential experience, but also in the field of social health and welfare building.

Some more significant projects in the field of landscape and street furniture include the redevelopment of Corso Italia - 1st section "in Gorizia, the redevelopment of the Via Garibaldi, Mazzini and the Nuns in Gorizia and in the 2007-2010 period the redevelopment of the Via Rastello, Cocevia in Gorizia, carried out with the arch. Zlatich. In 2007 the studio, together with Bauburo and the Fierro studio in Bolzano, won the tender for the redevelopment of Piazza Libertà in Trieste, a work of € 3.25m. After several changes to the project, this September sees the start of work. Luciano Lazzari carries out the activity of operational director on site.

In 2008 the study carried out a feasibility study and subsequent preliminary project for the renovation of Piazzale Roma on behalf of ASM s.p.a.

For the Municipality of Muggia the studio won the tender for the arrangement of the Piazza Caliterna in Muggia, work completed in 2007.

In the building field the arch. Lazzari has recently obtained approval for a hotel and spa complex in Latronico, Potenza for a value of € 13m and is planning the renovation with the expansion of two hotels in Chianciano Terme.

Currently the work of restructuring and conversion of an agricultural shed to use a new wine cellar, restaurant, resale of typical products, cooking school and teaching rooms in Sarteano in the province of Siena is being tested.
