

GO! 2025, Nova Gorica and Gorizia European capital of culture

Public invitation to submit proposals for the coorganisation of events in 2021

The GO! 2025 project team invites operators to submit proposals for the coorganisation of events in the framework of preparatory activities for the development of the GO! 2025 European capital of culture. The aim of the public invitation is to strengthen the artistic creativity and to enhance cultural activities in the included area of the GO! 2025

Participation requirements for applicants:

- the applicant is a non-governmental organisation with headquarters in the territory of the European Union;
- the applicant is the organiser of an event or sets of events in the included area of the European Capital of Culture 2025 (North Primorska Statistical Region, Municipality of Komen, Friuli Venezia Giulia);
- Priority will be given to projects involving / connecting different organisations:
 - o Collegiate organisations from different municipalities in the field of ECC GO! 2025
 - o Local and national collegiate organisations
 - o Local and international collegiate organisations.

Content of proposals:

- the subject of the invitation are events or sets of events in the field of culture and art (preferably) and activities that promote civic activity.
- the content of the proposals must be in line with the objectives and values of GO! Borderless, defined in the final bidbook for the title of European capital of culture 2025;
- events or sets of events must be fully implemented in the calendar year 2021;
- the content priority of the events is: cross-border nature, inclusion of vulnerable groups, involvement of artists from the included area, involvement of young people;
- proposals must be either new events or a substantive upgrade or extension of already established events;
- each applicant may submit only one proposal, and the proposal may contain several interrelated activities.

The deadline for submission of proposals is **Wednesday, the 7th of July, 2021, at 12 noon**. Proposals must be submitted by the applicants on the form attached to this public invitation and sent to the email address: info@go2025.eu.

The proposals will be assessed and evaluated by a three-member commission appointed by the European Grouping of Territorial Cooperation (hereinafter EGTC GO) according to the criteria annexed to this invitation. The Commission will select a maximum of ten (10) best-rated proposals.

With the selected applicants, the EGTC GO will sign a coorganisational agreement, with which it will undertake to cover up to 50 percent of the costs of organising the project, up to an amount not exceeding 2,000 (two thousand) euros.

The coorganization service will be entrusted pursuant to art. 1, paragraph 2, letter a) of the Legislative Decree No 76/2020 "Simplification Decree", converted with amendments by Law 120/2020 and revised by Legislative Decree 77/2021 (Direct Procurement). Verification of the actual possession of the requirements pursuant to art. 80 of Legislative Decree 50/2016 and subsequent amendments (absence of causes for exclusion from participation in tenders) will be carried out before taking on the assignment.
